Meet Terms and Conditions – Version 1.03

1. General Conditions

- a. KNZB meet rules apply.
- b. Only FINA approved swimwear is permitted
- c. Current general information, about accommodation for example, can be found on the website: <http://itt.psvzwemmen.nl>. All enquiries can be sent by email to: itt@psvzwemmen.nl.
- d. The event will be held in a 10-lane competition pool (50m, electronic timing).
- e. Swimmers will have access to the 4-lane training pool (50m) for warming-up and cooling-down. The 8-lane diving pool (25m) will not be accessible due to the hosting of the Master Diving Cup there.
- f. There will be directions in the main entrance for swimmers and spectators. The ticket desk will be open for spectators, half an hour before the meet starts. The swimmers may then also go to the spectators' galleries. The changing rooms will be accessible for swimmers, a quarter of an hour before warming-up.

2. Entries

- a. Entry closes at 23:59 on Tuesday 18th February 2020.
- b. Entry fees will be due as soon as entry closes. The costs are: Euro 3.00 per 50m distance; Euro 3.50 per 100m distance; Euro 4.00 per 200m distance and Euro 5.00 per 400m distance. Entries submitted before 1st January 2020 get a Euro 0.50 discount per distance.
- c. A club may enter multiple teams. Instructions how to do this are enclosed, and can be found via this [link](#).
- d. Qualifying times must be achieved in the period between 1st January 2018 until and including 16th February 2020.
- e. Entry submissions will be accepted by email only. The SPLASH/Lenex file and list of participants as a PDF file must be attached. The required number of team leader passes should be stated in the email. Submission should be completed with contact details in Splash Team Manager (see link in point 3).
- f. All file names should include the club name, according to the following example: 2020-02-10=Club Name-ITT-inschr.lxf or 2020-02-10=Club Name-ITT-inschr.pdf.

- g. All submissions and files should be sent to itt@psvzwemmen.nl. The subject title should be: "Entry ITT 2020 Club Name".
- h. Entries received in good order will be confirmed with an email from the organiser.
- i. If qualifying times have been achieved but not yet uploaded into the web calendar, nor shown in Swimrankings.net, this should be stated in the submission email, with verification of results either linked or attached as a PDF.
- j. Entry times should always be the fastest times swum during the qualification period. Event, place and date of achievement of the entry time should be shown. The 50m times have precedence over 25m times.

3. Officials

- a. A list of officials should be sent before entries close.
- b. Each club should supply 1 official per 4 swimmers. This means 1 official with 1-4 swimmers, 2 officials with 5-8 swimmers, 3 officials with 9-12 swimmers etc.
- c. A list of officials can be sent by email to: officialcoordinator@psvzwemmen.nl
- d. Failure to supply the required amount of officials may result in refusal of entry.

4. Administration

- a. A list of officials should be sent before entries close.
- b. In order to limit the length of each session, only the fastest swimmers per event number will be placed. However, the ratio of Junior verses Youth in each event number will be taken into account. Ratio Junior 1-2: Junior 3-4: Youth 1-2 is 1:1:1.
- c. The organiser reserves the right to enter PSV Zwemmen swimmers who might not otherwise have been placed based on their registration time.
- d. The organiser reserves the right to admit international teams regardless of their entry times.
- e. Each club will get a number of programmes together with their swimmers and coaches' tickets. There will be one programme per coach and one programme per club. Coaches not registered will be refused entry.
- f. Results will be published live on SplashMe and <http://itt.psvzwemmen.nl>.

- h. The start lists will be published on the ITT website, on Saturday 29th February 2020.
- i. Withdrawals submitted before 17:00 on 5th March 2020 will be shown in the results as AFGEM. Hereafter, they will be shown as NG. In both cases, starting fees will still be charged. A non-registered withdrawal will be fined an extra Euro 10.00
- j. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to participants and/or coaches and to adapt meet regulations to fit changes in circumstance.
- k. Each team consists a minimum of 10 and maximum of 12 swimmers. The ratio of Juniors 1-2:Juniors 3-4:Youth 1-2 is 1:1:1 en ratio girls-boys is 1:1. If a club doesn't have enough swimmers for a team, then swimmers can be entered for individual distances.
- l. Swimmers must be within the age categories for Juniors 1-4 or Youth 1-2 according to the KNZB age conditions for season 2019-2020.

5. Events

- a. **Team Finale:** The ITT 2020 will close with a team final consisting a number of relays. The 8 teams with the most FINA points qualify for a place in the team final.

Only the FINA points of the fastest swimmer per event per age category (Juniors 1-2, Juniors 3-4, Youth 1-2) per team, count.

A different points system applies to the team final. The following points can be gained, per team per relay are:

Winner/1 st place:	20 points	5 th place:	8 points
2 nd place:	16 points	6 th place:	6 points
3 rd place:	12 points	7 th place:	4 points
4 th place:	10 points	8 th place:	2 points

The team that gains the most points during the team final wins the International Talent Trophy (challenge cup). If there's a draw in points at the team final, then the team that gained the most points before the team final wins. It's important to note that only registered teams are allowed to take part in the team final; it's not permitted to supplement these teams with other swimmers.

- b. **The Crown Race ("Kroontjes Race"):** This is a 50m Freestyle event for the 10 girls and 10 boys of each age category (Juniors 1-2, Juniors 3-4, Youth 1-2) who have gained the highest total number of FINA points during the ITT. Lanes are split into age category. The number 10 swimmer in each lane swims the first heat, then sits, wearing cape and crown, on the throne at the end of their lane (each lane has its own cape, crown and throne). Then the number 9 swimmer in each lane swims the second heat. If the number 9 swimmer is faster than the number 10 swimmer was, then the number 9 swimmer takes the cape and crown from the number 10 swimmer, and sits on the throne. If the number 10 swimmer achieved a faster time then that swimmer stays on the throne. And so this event

goes on, until the number 1 swimmer has swum the tenth heat. The fastest swimmer in each lane wins the crown and becomes the King or Queen of their age category!

- c. **The Mystery Medley Race:** This is an 8 x 50m Medley relay event where the order of strokes varies per lane! There will be a sign at each lane indicating the order of the different strokes (always 2x Butterfly, 2x Backstroke, 2x Breaststroke and 2x Freestyle) should be swum. Teams must be registered with a set order of swimmers. Each team is allocated a lane by lottery; the referee draws the tickets with lane numbers, before each heat starts.

One club, multiple teams.

For the Regional Minors Club Meet and the KNZB Swimming Competition, it is possible for a club to participate with multiple teams. This document shows how to enrol multiple teams in SPLASH Team and Meet Manager. The procedure has been simplified for both the enrolling club and the organising club.

NB: When a club participates in the National Competition, with multiple teams or has a 1st or 2nd guest team, it is compulsory to follow these procedures, as they are directly linked to the calculation of the competition results.

The procedure basically involves the following steps:

- Ensure you have the most up-to-date version of Team Manager
- Input the invitation
- Make multiple teams in one go
- Enter the swimmers, per team
- Input the teams in Meet Manager in the usual manner
- **Hold a meet**
- Input in Team Manager is now easy

Input the invitation

This is reduced to one-off meet input

Create multiple teams in one go

Here it's necessary to enter multiple teams in Team Manager. This is done at the section "Clubs", by entering the same club each time but numbered consecutively.

This results in the same club multiple times, each time followed by a different, but consecutive number.

Entries per team

Now the entries per team can be made. Make sure the correct club is selected each time.

One club, multiple teams

Entries can now be sent by email via the program. Both teams go as one Lenex file.

Inputting entries in Meet Manager

After input, the different teams can be viewed in an overview.

The meet can be completed in the usual manner. Be aware that if a swimmer is copied from the main database that this swimmer will have an incorrect depot-number if the swimmer is also allocated to the second or following team. The meet can be saved in the usual manner, in a LENEX file.

Processing results in Team Manager

This can be done in the usual manner. The meet is now complete.

Amending in Meet Manager

When the above mentioned is not carried out, it is still possible to enter team numbers in Meet Manager. Click on the relevant club in the overview of participating clubs and amend the number in the club details.
