Terms and Conditions – version 2.0

- a. KNZB meet rules apply.
- b. Only FINA approved swimwear is permitted.
- c. Current general information, about accommodation for example, can be found on the website: http://itt.psvzwemmen.nl.
 All enquiries can be sent by email to: itt@psvzwemmen.nl.
- d. The event will be held in a 10-lane competition pool (50m) with electronic timing.
- e. Swimmers will have access to the 8-lane diving pool (25m) for warming-up and cooling-down. The 4-lane training pool (50m) will not be accessible for ITT participants.
- f. Information about where and when swimmers and *spectators can check-in will be available at the main entrance. The ticket desk will be open for *spectators, half an hour before the start. The swimmers may then also go to the spectators' galleries. The changing rooms will be accessible for swimmers, a quarter of an hour before warming-up.

g. Entry procedure:

- 1. Entry opens Monday 1st February and closes Wednesday 17th February 2021 at 23:59.
- 2. Entry fees are: Euro 3.00 per 50m distance; Euro 3.50 per 100m distance; Euro 4.00 per 200m distance and Euro 5.00 per 400m distance.
- 3. A club may enter multiple teams. Instructions how to do this are enclosed, and can be found via this link.
- 4. Qualifying times must be achieved in the period between 1st January 2019 until and including 14th February 2021.
- 5. Entries must be sent by email to: wedstrijdsecretariaat@psvzwemmen.nl. The SPLASH/Lenex file and list of participants as a PDF file must be attached. The number of 'team coach' passes required should also be stated in the email. Entries must be completed by entering contact details in Splash Team Manager (see link in point 3).
- 6. All file names should include the club name, as in the following examples:
 - a. 2021-02-10=Club Name-ITT-inschr.lxf
 - b. 2021-02-10=Club Name-ITT-inschr.pdf.
- All files should be sent via email to wedstrijdsecretariaat@psvzwemmen.nl. The subject title should be: "Entry ITT 2020 + Club Name".
- 8. Entries received in good order will be confirmed via an email from the organiser.
- If qualifying times have been achieved but not yet uploaded into the web calendar or Swimrankings.net, this should be stated in the entry email, along with verification of the achieved times either via a link or attached as a PDF.
- 10. Qualifying times are always the fastest times swum during the given qualification period. Event, place and date of achievement of the qualifying time should be stated with the entry. 50m times have precedence over 25m times.
- h. A list of accompanying officials should be received before entry closes.





- 1. Each club should supply 1 official per 4 swimmers. This means 1 official for 1-4 swimmers, 2 officials for 5-8 swimmers, 3 officials for 9-12 swimmers etc.
- 2. A list of officials can be sent by email to: officialcoordinator@psvzwemmen.nl
- 3. Failure to supply the required amount of officials may result in refusal of entry.
- i. In order to limit the length of each session, only the fastest swimmers per event number will be placed. However, the ratio of Junior-Youth in each event number will be taken into account. Ratio Junior 1-2: Junior 3-4: Youth 1-2 is 1:1:1.
- j. The organiser reserves the right to enter own swimmers who might not otherwise have been entered based on their fastest time.
- k. The organiser reserves the right to admit international teams regardless of their qualifying times.
- I. Each club will get a number of programmes with their swimmers and coaches' tickets (one programme per coach plus one programme per club). Coaches not registered in advance will be refused entry.
- m. Results will be published live on SplashMe and http://itt.psvzwemmen.nl.

- o. The heat sheets/meet programme will be published on the ITT website, on Saturday 6th March 2021.
- p. Withdrawals submitted before 16:00 on 10th March 2021 will be shown in the results as AFGEM. Withdrawals submitted thereafter will be shown as NG. In both cases, entry fees will still be charged. Withdrawals not submitted before the race will also receive a fine of Euro 10.00.
- q. The organiser reserves the right to refuse entry to participants and/or coaches and to adapt meet regulations to fit changes of circumstance.
- r. The International Talent Trophy will be awarded to the best team in the finals. Each team consists of 12 swimmers, with a ratio of:
 - a. 2 x boys (2007-2008) and 2 x girls Junior 1-2 (2008-2009)
 - b. 2 x boys (2005-2006) and 2 x girls Junior 3-4 (2006-2007)
 - c. 2 x boys (2003-2004) and 2 x girls Youth 1-2 (2004-2005)





Associations are free to register multiple teams as described in g.3. If an association cannot bring enough swimmers together for an (additional) team, those swimmers can be registered without a team. These swimmers can then normally participate in the competition and also compete in the points classification of the Crown Race.

A team that is not assembled as mentioned above will not be admitted as a team. The swimmers will be added to the program as regular swimmers.

- s. Swimmers must be within the age categories for Juniors 1-4 and/or Youth 1-2, according to the KNZB age regulations for season 2020-2021.
- t. **Team Finale:** The ITT 2020 will round off on the Sunday with a team finale consisting a number of relays. The 8 teams with the most FINA points qualify for a place in the team finale. Only the FINA points of the fastest swimmer, per event, per age category (Juniors 1-2, Juniors 3-4, Youth 1-2) and per team count for qualification.

A different points system applies for the team finale. The following points can be gained, per team, per relay in order of finish:

Winner/1st place:	20 points	5 th place:	8 points
2 nd place:	16 points	6 th place:	6 points
3 rd place:	12 points	7 th place:	4 points
4 th place:	10 points	8 th place:	2 points

The team that gains the most points during the team finale wins the International Talent Trophy (challenge cup). If there's a draw, then the team that achieved the most points before the team finale wins. It's important to note that only registered teams are allowed to take part in the team finale; it's not permitted to supplement these teams with other swimmers.

Teams that have qualified for the finals must submit their team classification for the finals before the start of program number 33 (Crown Race). Teams that have not submitted a classification to the organization will be excluded from participation in the finals.

In the finals, each team member must swim exactly twice. If this is not complied with, the team will be excluded from participation in the finals.

u. Crown Race ("Kroontjes Race"): This is a 50m Freestyle event for the 10 girls and 10 boys of each age category (Juniors 1-2, Juniors 3-4, Youth 1-2) who have gained the highest total number of FINA points during the ITT. Lanes are divided into age category. The number 10 swimmer in each lane swims the first heat, puts on a cape and crown and sits on the "throne" (chair) at the end of their lane (each lane has its own cape, crown and "throne"). Then the number nine swimmer in each lane swims the second heat. If this swimmer is faster than the last swimmer, they take the cape and crown and sit on the "throne". Otherwise the number 10 swimmer stays on the "throne". And so this event goes on, until the number one swimmer has swum the tenth





- heat. The fastest swimmer in each lane wins the crown and becomes the King or Queen of their age category!
- v. **The Mystery Medley Race:** This is a 8 x 50m Medley relay event where the *unusual* order of strokes differs per lane! There will be a sign at each lane indicating the order of strokes for that lane (always including 2 x Butterfly, 2 x Backstroke, 2 x Breaststroke and 2 x Freestyle). Teams must state their order of swimmers with their entry submission. Each team is allocated a lane by lottery; the referee draws the tickets with lane numbers, before the start of each heat.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Terms and conditions may change according to guidelines and rules of the RIVM (Dutch ministry of health) concerning the current pandemic. The organisers always put health and safety first.

One club, multiple teams.

It is possible for a club to participate with multiple teams, at the Regional Minors Club Meet and the KNZB Swimming Competition. This document shows how to enter multiple teams using SPLASH Team and Meet Manager. This has been simplified for both the enrolling club and the organising club.

NB: If a club participates in a National Competition, with multiple teams or with a 1st or 2nd guest team, it is important to follow this procedure, as they are directly linked to the calculation of the competition results.

The procedure basically involves the following steps:

- Ensure you have the most up-to-date version of Team Manager
- Input the invitation
- Make multiple teams in one go
- Enter the swimmers, per team
- Input the teams in Meet Manager in the usual manner
- Hold a meet
- Input in Team Manager is now easy

Input the invitation

This is reduced to one-off meet input

Create multiple teams in one go

Here it's necessary to enter multiple teams in Team Manager. This is done at the section "Clubs", by entering the same club each time but numbered consecutively.

This results in the same club multiple times, each time followed by a different, but consecutive number.

Entries per team

Now the entries per team can be made. Make sure the correct club is selected each time.

One club, multiple teams

Entries can now be sent by email via the program. Both teams go as one Lenex file.

Inputting entries in Meet Manager

After input, the different teams can be viewed in an overview.

The meet can be completed in the usual manner. Be aware that if a swimmer is copied from the main database that this swimmer will have an incorrect depotnumber if the swimmer is also allocated to the second or following team. The meet can be saved in the usual manner, in a LENEX file.

Processing results in Team Manager

This can be done in the usual manner. The meet is now complete.

Amending in Meet Manager

When the above mentioned is not carried out, it is still possible to enter team numbers in Meet Manager. Click on the relevant club in the overview of participating clubs and amend the number in the club details.
