PSV Zwemmen first organised The International Talent Trophy (ITT) in 2019, to give young swimmers from different countries a taste of competing at an international event. Following American example, the ITT is a team-based tournament, though individual performance counts as well. Its international allure is something quite unique for young swimmers.

### **General Terms and Conditions – version 3.1**

- KNZB meet rules apply.
- A club may enter multiple teams. If a club does not have enough swimmers for one or more teams, then individual swimmers may be entered. Every swimmers performance counts towards qualifying for the Crown Race.
- Only FINA approved swimwear is permitted
- During the tournament, swimmers will have access to the 8-lane diving pool (25m) for warming-up and cooling-down. The 4-lane training pool (50m) will not be accessible for ITT participants.

### **International Talent Trophy (for teams only)**

- A team consists of 12 swimmers, according to the following line-up (*subject to KNZB rules 2021-2022*):
  - 2 boys (2009 – 2008) and 2 girls (2010 – 2009)
  - 2 boys (2007 – 2006) and 2 girls (2008 - 2007)
  - 2 boys (2004 – 2005) and 2 girls (2006 – 2005)
- Line-ups differing from the above will not be entered as a team. The swimmers will be entered individually. See attached document “Team line-ups ITT” for clarity. The trophy will be presented to the best team in the finales.

- Qualification for the team finale (programme 34, 35, 36 and 37) on Sunday, depends on points gained throughout the tournament. The 8 teams with the most FINA-points get placed in the team finale.
  - Placement depends on the FINA-points of the fastest swimmer per programme per age category, per team.
- The following applies to the 8 qualifying teams:
  - Team line-ups for programmes 34, 35, 36 and 37 must be confirmed to the jury before programme 33 (Crown Race). Failure to do so will result in the team being excluded from the finale.
  - Each team member must swim twice in the finale. Failure to do so will result in the team being excluded from the finale.
  - It is not permitted for other swimmers to supplement a team.
  - A different points system applies to the team-finale. The following points can be earned per team per relay in order of finish:
 

1 <sup>st</sup> 20 points	5 <sup>th</sup> 8 points
2 <sup>nd</sup> 16 points	6 <sup>th</sup> 6 points
3 <sup>rd</sup> 12 points	7 <sup>th</sup> 4 points
4 <sup>th</sup> 10 points	8 <sup>th</sup> 2 points
- The team with the most points at the end of the team-finale wins the International Talent Trophy. In the event of a draw, the FINA-points achieved before the team-finale will be decisive.

### **Mystery Medley Relay**

The Mystery Medley Relay is a team-finale full of surprise!

Team line-ups must be confirmed to the jury before the Crown Race starts.

Before each heat, the teams are allocated lanes by means of a lottery. The referee draws the lottery tickets; every ticket has a lane number on it. The teams then go to their allocated lane where there will be a noticeboard showing the 8 x 50m medley that they will have to swim. Each lane gets a different combination of the 4 medley strokes, and each swimmer must swim twice.

Team line-ups cannot be changed once delivered to the jury.

### **Crown Race for individual swimmers and team members**

This is a 50m freestyle event for the 10 girls and 10 boys of each age category, who have gained the highest total number of FINA-points during the ITT.

Lanes are divided into age category. The tenth swimmer of the line-up at each lane swims the first heat and takes their place on the throne at the end of their lane. Then the ninth swimmer of the line-up at each lane swims the second heat. If this swimmer is faster than the one before, then this swimmer takes the place on the throne. If not, the swimmer on the throne stays there. And so this goes on until the first swimmer in the line-up at each lane has swum their heat. This way, the fastest swimmer per lane becomes the King or Queen of their age category!

- All swimmers can qualify for the Crown Race any time during the ITT, whether they are partaking individually or as a team member.
- Withdrawal from the Crown Race is allowed up to 15 minutes prior the announcement of the finale line-up.

## Entry procedure

- Entry opens Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022 and closes at 23:59 on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
- Entry fees are due once entry closes.
- Entry fees are: Eur 3.00 per 50m heat, Eur 3.50 per 100m heat, Eur 4.00 per 200m heat and Eur 5.00 per 400m heat.
- Qualifying times must have been achieved between 1st January 2019 and 6th March 2022 inclusive.
- Entry times should always be the fastest times swum during the given qualification period. Event, place and date of achievement of the entry time should be stated. The 50m times have precedence over 25m times.
- If entry times have been achieved but not yet uploaded into the web calendar, nor shown in Swimrankings.net, this should be stated in the submission email, with verification of the times attached in a PDF or via a link.
- Entries should be sent by email to [wedstrijdsecretariaat@psvzwemmen.nl](mailto:wedstrijdsecretariaat@psvzwemmen.nl) and must include the following:
  - SPLASH/Lenex file (including contact details in Splash Team Manager)
  - List of participants (PDF) in order of name
  - List of participants (PDF) in order of programme
  - Completed form "Team line-up ITT (attached)
  - Team photo for social media (not obligatory but appreciated)"
  - Required number of coach passes (state in the email)
- The email subject should be as follows:
  - Entry ITT 2022 Club Name
- All file names should include the club name as follows:
  - 2022-02-10=Club Name-ITT-entry.lxf
  - 2022-02-10=Club Name-ITT-entry.pdf
- Before entry closes the required number of officials should be confirmed.
  - Per club there should be 1 official per 4 swimmers (1 official for 1 to 4 swimmers, 2 officials for 5 to 8 swimmers and 3 officials for 9 to 12 swimmers, and so on).
  - A list of officials can be sent by email to [officialcoordinator@psvzwemmen.nl](mailto:officialcoordinator@psvzwemmen.nl). The list should be in order of day (Friday, Saturday, Sunday).
  - Failure to supply the required number of officials may result in refusal of entry.
- Entries received in good order will be confirmed by email.

## Entering multiple teams

- Clubs may enter more than one team. Instructions on how to do this can be found attached and via this link:

- In order to limit the length of each programme, only the fastest swimmers per event will be entered. The ratio junior : youth per programme, will be taken into consideration.
- The organiser reserves the right to also admit swimmers of their own who may not have achieved qualifying times.
- The organiser reserves the right to admit international teams regardless of their entry times.

## Participant lists and withdrawals

- A list of participants will be published on the ITT website, on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
- Withdrawals submitted up to 16:00 on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2022 will be shown as AFGEM on the list of participants. Thereafter they will be shown as NG. In both cases, starting fees will still be charged. Failure to notify a withdrawal (a 'no-show') will incur a further fine of Eur 10.00.

## On the day itself

- Routes for swimmers and spectators will be shown at the main entrance of Nationaal Zwemcentrum De Tongelreep.
- The ticket desk will be open for spectators, half an hour before the start.
- Swimmers can go to the changing rooms half an hour before warming-up starts.
- Poolside passes for swimmers and their coach will be available for each club, together with a number of programme books. There will be one programme book per coach plus one programme book per club. Coaches not registered beforehand will be refused entry.
- Results will be published live in the SplashMe app, and at: <http://itt.psvzwemmen.nl>.

## Attachment: Example of multiple team entry.

### One club, multiple teams.

This document shows how to enter multiple teams using SPLASH-Team and Meet-Manager. This has been simplified for both the entering club and for the organiser.

**NB: If a club participates with multiple teams or with a 1st or 2nd guest team, it is important to follow this procedure, as this is directly linked to the calculation of the competition results.**

The procedure basically concerns the following steps:

- Ensure you have the most recent version of Team-Manager.
- Import the invitation
- Create multiple teams
- Enter the swimmers, per team
- Import the teams in Meet-Manager


### Import the invitation

This has been simplified to enable import in one go.

### Create multiple teams

This is done at the section “Clubs”.

First create the teams. Each team requires a new entry, with club name and a consecutive team number.



### Process results in Team-Manager

This can be done in the usual way to complete the process.

### Amend in Meet-Manager

It is still possible to amend team numbers in Meet-Manager, even after the above has been completed. Click on the relevant club in the overview of participating clubs and amend the team number in the club details.
