Regulations – Version 4.3

The International Talent Trophy (ITT) is being organised by PSV Swimming and is intended to get youth members acquainted with competitions with an international character. PSV swimming is organising a competition for juniors and youth with a new flavour for the Netherlands. Following an American example there is a team competition, but of course individual achievements also count. It's a competition with international allure, not often seen for younger swimmers.

General conditions

- The competition will be swum in a 50m pool under KNZB rules.
- Clubs are free to enter several teams, to a maximum of 3 teams. If a club cannot get enough swimmers together for a (or an additional) team, those swimmers can be entered **individually**, provided they meet the age criteria. **All** swimmers compete in the points ranking for the Crown Race.
- Only swimwear approved by **FINA** is allowed.
- During the competition swimmers may use the 8-lane diving pool (25m) for warming up and cooling down. The 4-lane training pool is not accessible for ITT participants.
- The organisation will take pictures of the teams and the awards ceremony. General photos of the competition will also be taken and can be found after the competition on the website <http://itt.psvzwemmen.nl>

International Talent Trophy (conditions for teams only)

- a. A team consists of 12 swimmers (*age categories provisional, rules 2022-2023 KNZB*):

• 2 boys born in 2009 or 2010			juniors 1-2
• 2 boys born in 2007 or 2008			juniors 3-4
• 2 boys born in 2005 or 2006			youth 1-2
• 2 girls born in 2010 or 2011			juniors 1-2
• 2 girls born in 2008 or 2009			juniors 3-4
• 2 girls born in 2006 or 2007			youth 1-2
- b. If a team is ***not*** composed as described above, it will not be accepted as team. *The swimmers will in that case be added to the programme as regular swimmers.* To prevent mistakes it is recommended to use the appendix “Team composition ITT”.
- c. During the competition teams will amass points with which they can qualify for the team final. Per event (so both for girls and for boys) the fastest swimmer of the team per age category is determined. The FINA points of this swimmer count towards the total points of the team. The 8 teams with the most FINA points will qualify for the team final.
- d. The team final determines who wins the International Talent Trophy. The team final consists of events 36, 37, 38 and 39 of the programme to be swum on Sunday afternoon.
- e. The following applies to the best 8 teams who qualify:

- Before the start of event 35 (Crown Race) every qualified team must submit the team composition for events 36, 37, 38 and 39 to the organisation on the form that can be found in the appendix.
- In the team final every team member must swim exactly 2 events. If this condition is not met, the team will be disqualified.
- Teams may not be supplemented with other swimmers.
- Teams who did not submit a team composition are excluded from participation in the team final.
- In the team final the score begins at 0. The teams can then win the following points in events 36, 37, 38 and 39:

1 st place:	20 points	5 th place:	8 points
2 nd place:	16 points	6 th place:	6 points
3 rd place:	12 points	7 th place:	4 points
4 th place:	10 points	8 th place:	2 points

The team who thus amasses the most points during the team final wins the International Talent Trophy (challenge cup). In case of an equal number of points the FINA points scored before the team final will decide.

f. Event 39: Mystery Medley Relay

The Mystery Medley Relay (event 39) is an 8x50 m medley relay full of surprises, because the order of the strokes is different for each team. The composition (the order of the swimmers) must be submitted to the jury **before** event 35 (Crown Race). Before the start of the relay the referee will decide by draw which team will swim in which lane. Each lane has an indication of which order the 8x50 medley must be swum in. This is different for each lane, but will always consists of 2x butterfly, 2x backstroke, 2x breaststroke and 2x freestyle. **The boys will start on the start side and the girls on the turn side. The stroke swum down by the boys will be swum back by the girls.** Naturally the order of swimmers may not be changed anymore behind the blocks. Backstroke is started from the water.

Event 35 Crown Race (conditions for individual swimmers and team members)

- a. The 10 best boys and 10 best girls of each of the three age categories will qualify for the Crown Race. Qualification is based on the FINA points that the swimmer achieved in his or her 6 best individual events on Friday and Saturday.
- b. During the Crown Race the swimmers will race a 50m freestyle. Every age category will swim in its own lane; the girls in lanes 2, 3 and 4 and the boys in lanes 6, 7 and 8.
- c. The numbers 10 of each category will start first and can take a seat on the throne after the race. After this the numbers 9 of each age category will swim. If number 9 is faster than number 10, number 9 will take over the throne. If not, number 10 stays on the throne. This will continue through the 10th heat with the numbers 1. The fastest swimmer is the king or queen of his or her category.
- d. All swimmers can qualify for the Crown Race during the tournament.
It does not matter if you participate individually or in a team.
- e. Withdrawing from this race can be done until 1 hour after the classification for the Crown Race is done on Sunday morning.

Entries (also for individual participants) The

entry procedure for the ITT is as follows:

- **There are 3 time blocks for entries;**
 1. For **foreign teams** entries will open on October 1st, 2022 and close on November 30th 2022.
 2. For **Dutch teams** entries will open on December 1st 2022 and close on January 31st 2023.
 3. For **individual swimmers** entries will open on February 1st and close on February 15th 2023.

Teams who have submitted their entries in the set period are guaranteed of a place.

- Until 15th February 2023 swimmers in a team may be replaced by other swimmers. The races the original swimmers were entered in will remain the same, however, so the new swimmer will swim the races of the old swimmer.
- Individual swimmers also have to comply with the condition that boys must be born between 2005 and 2010 and girls must be born between 2006 and 2011.
- After the entries are closed, the entry fees are due. Entry fees are € 5,00 per individual event and € 10,00 per relay.

Entry times must be swum in the period **1st September 2021 until 15th February 2023.**

- The entry times must always be the fastest time swum during the qualifying period. Long course (50m) times take precedence over short course (25m) times.
- For checking purposes all entry times must include date and location of the races where they were achieved.
- When the times that are used for entering have not yet been uploaded in the web calendar or to swimrankings.net, you must mention this in the email and include results (pdf or link to results).
- Entries can be emailed to wedstrijdsecretariaat@psvzwemmen.nl with the subject line "Entry ITT 2023 + the name of your club". The entry must contain the following files:
 1. SPLASH/Lenex-file (including contact details in Splash Teammanager)
 2. List of participants (PDF file) by name
 3. List of participants (PDF file) by event
 4. Completely filled out appendix 'Teamindeling ITT'
 5. Team photo for social media (not compulsory, but desired)
 6. The number of coaches cards needed
- All file names must contain the club name according to the following example:
 - 2023-02-10=Club-ITT-entry.lxf
 - 2023-02-10=Club-ITT-entry.pdf
- Per club a maximum of 3 teams may be entered, The description of how you can enter multiple teams is included in the appendix of these regulations and can be found via this link:

- When you have personally received an email from the organisation and you have supplied all officials, your entry will have been done successfully.

Officials

- Before the closing of the entries we should also like to receive your officials, via officialcoordinator@psvzwemmen.nl
- Per club we expect 1 official per 4 swimmers per day. This means 1 official in case of 1-4 swimmers, 2 officials for 5-8 swimmers, 3 officials for 9-12 swimmers etc.
- The officials must be communicated at the same time as the entries. Please indicate in the email which officials are available on Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday.
- If not enough officials have been provided, the entry may be refused.

Seeding

- In order to limit the length of each session to a maximum, only the fastest swimmers per event will be seeded. The ratio juniors-youth in each event will be taken into consideration, however.
- The organising club reserves the right, due to time constraints, to combine heats and have a maximum number of heats.
- The organising club reserves the right to admit PSV swimmers who would otherwise not be seeded due to their entry times.
- The organising club reserves the right to admit foreign clubs in their entirety regardless of their entry times.

Startlists and withdrawals

- The start lists will be published on Wednesday 1 March 2023 on the ITT website <http://itt.psvzwemmen.nl>
- Withdrawals made until Thursday 9 March 2023, 12.00 (midday), will be included in the results as AFGEM. After this moment it will be NG. Entry fees are due in both cases. In case of an NG without withdrawal a fine of €10,- will be added to the entry fee.

On the day

- Participants and spectators of the ITT will be directed where to go in the main entrance hall.
- Half an hour before the warming up the ticket desk for spectators will be opened.
- Participants may go to the changing rooms half an hour before the start of the warming up.
- For each participating club there will be participants' cards and coaches' cards along with a few start lists. 1 list per coach and 1 extra list per club will be provided. Coaches not submitted beforehand will not be allowed entry to the pool.

De procedure in het kort bevat de volgende stappen:



- Zorg dat u de nieuwste versie van Team Manager heeft.


